Root Crops Sales



Taro, Maniota and Kumara continues to be the most consistent root crop supplied at the market. When compared to the previous month, a reduction in the quantities of all root crops was noted apart from kumara, turmeric and ginger. Bad weather conditions at the end of the month and inconsistent farming patterns

are believed to be some reasons for the decrease in supply. On the other hand, the minimal increase in the supply of tumeric, kumara and ginger ensured some root crops were available for sale at the market.

Fruit Sales



A decrease in the supply of all fruits was noted apart from watermelon, pawpaw, capsicum and lemon. The supply of watermelon has increased by 77%. Although this is not an ideal time to grow watermelon due to risk of diseases, some farmers managed to harvest and supply

the fruit. Cooler weather conditions played a significant role in the increase of capsicum and lemon being supplied by 28% and 8% respectively. Farmers have also managed to harvest a new variety of capsicum (red in color). There was a reduction in the supply of fruits like drinking nuts, oranges, eggplants, cucumber and tomatoes. Off-peak season was the key reason for the decrease in the supply of bananas by 50%.
