Root Crops & Fruits


Similar to last quarter, it is reported that all of the crops that were harvested on Atiu was allocated for home consumption only and not made available for sale. These comprised of Maniota, Tarua, Yam, Taro, Banana and Pawpaw.

60% of the land utilized for agricultural purposes was used for the planting of root crops and the remaining areas were used for the planting of vegetables and fruit trees for this quarter. An increase in the land used for fruit trees has been noted for this quarter. We see this as a result of the training in marcotting and pruning provided by the Ministry to Atiu Agriculture staff.

<u>Livestock</u>



Pigs, Goats and Chicken were the only livestock reported by the farmers for this quarter. Chickens comprised 68% of the total livestock followed by pigs and goats.

<u>Note</u>: Livestock data collected are only for those being well managed by farmers.
