Root Crops Sales



Taro and Maniota continues to be the most consistently supplied root crop on the market, even-though quantities have declined from previous months by 21% and 51% respectively. These

reductions was due to the absence of tourists on the island and with only few customers buying from the market, making vendors opt to harvest and bring only a few. Other root crops sold at the market were turmeric, white and red radish.

Fruit Sales



An increase in the supply of Cucumber, Capsicum, Orange, Pumpkin, Lemon, Watermelon and Snake Beans was noted this month. Tomatoes was the

most supplied fruit to the market with over 1.3 ton this month. On the contrary, a notable reduction was seen in the supply of Pawpaw, Drinking nuts and Eggplants appearing at the market and roadside stalls. We anticipated an increase in the supply of these fruits in the coming months with farmers getting ready their crops for the Agriculture World Food Day. Other fruits not reported but sold in small quantities were Bitter melon, Passionfruit, Dragonfruit, Sweet Corn, Breadfruit, Mandarin, Choko, Soursop, Lime and Zucchini.

Vegetable Sales



A reduction in the supply of vegetables was noted this month. Watercress is the only vegetable showing increases in its market supply by 25% from two vendors. Lettuce of both hydroponic and tropical varieties were the most
