Root Crops Sales



Taro, Maniota and Kumara are still the most consistently supplied root crop on the market. Taro dominates the market with a total weight

provided of 318.7kg.

Fruits Sales

Drinking nuts are still popular and provided at



the market since January. Surprisingly, dragonfruit is still appearing consistently on the market with four

vendors supplying this month. Avocado, banana, corn, cucumber, eggplant, pawpaw, tomatoes and watermelon appeared on the market. Other tropical fruits that were provided, to the market for sale in small quantities this month were mandarin, passionfruit, bitter melon, okra, pineapple, jackfruit, breadfruit, starfruit, grapefruit, zucchini and soursop. These could be due to unfavorable weather conditions experienced this month affecting these crops and production coming to the end.

Vegetable Sales



Rukau is still the dominant leafy vegetable on the market sitting at 238.3kg this month, an increase from 233.5kg in March. We saw an increase in vendors

and volume in the Chinese cabbage (Pak Choi) this month as it is quick to grow and requires minimal maintenance. Watercress increased in volume due to production and market demand. It sells out as soon as it appears! Spring onion and lettuce continues to appear at the market but with reduced suppliers. Spinach and silverbeet also made an appearance on the market this month.
