Root Crops Sales



Taro and Maniota remain our top root crops surveyed this month, both showing increases from previous month by 90% and 37% respectively. Noticed also are the increases in the number of vendors selling these produces, an increase of 5

vendors for maniota and 3 for taro. Kumara is the only other root crop appearing on the market with over 55kgs.

Fruits Sales



Drinking Nuts and Watermelon continue to be popular on the market, showing increases when compared to previous month by 30% (480kgs) and 22% (275kgs) respectively. Of all the fruits reaching over the

100kqs threshold Cucumber, Pawpaw, Banana,

Avocado, Orange and Lemon all reported increases compared to March, whereas Dragon-fruit showed reductions in their market supplies. Pawpaw recorded the highest increases by 504kgs and followed by Drinking Nuts.

Other fruits appearing on the market in smaller quantities are Starfruits,

Snake Beans, Sweet Corn, Lime, Mandarin, Bitter melon, Capsicum, Pumpkin, Mangoes, Grapefruit, Zucchini, Passionfruit and Hog Plum.
