

Taro and Maniota remains the most consistently supplied root crop on the market. Taro averaged over 470kgs per month and Maniota averaged over 310kgs. Other promising root crops harvested this quarter and reported in small quantities were Kumara, Tumeric, white Radish and Ginger. Maniota is also noted as a valued added product sold in the form of grated, pudding (poke), plate of food enhancement and home consumption.



The table above showed fruits over the accumulated threshold of 100kgs reported during this quarter. Other tropical fruits harvested in smaller quantities appearing on the market are Sweet corn, Breadfruit, Soursop, Okra, Zucchini, Starfruit, Grapefruit, Mangoes,

Hog Plum, Bitter melon, custard apple, Lychee, Longan and Malay Apple.

Drinking nuts, Pawpaw, Tomatoes, Banana and Cucumber reported over a ton each for this quarter. Drinking nut supplied over 3 tons to the market and seen sold on roadsides in the town area, averaging a ton each month. Tomatoes also showed increases in quantities from July to September, over 290kgs and sold at average price of \$6.80/kg.

All vegetables showed increases by months with Cabbages tripling its quantities in September by over 320kgs when compared to July. Pak Choi, inclusive of Saladeer and Choysum remains steady averaging over 220kgs per month. Other vegetables harvested and reported in small quantities this quarter were Celery, Spinach, Brocolli, Cauliflower, Spring Onion and Silverbeet.
